1	Camera
2	Indicator light
3	PIR: In power-on mode, it will automatically enter standby state if no moving object is detected within 3meters within 30minutes; In standby mode, it automatically starts up when detecting moving objects within 3meters.
4	Lockhole
5	UPower Button: In startup mode, press the power button to mute. In standby mode, press the power button to power on.
6	AUDIO OUT: Used for external audio equipment

7	RJ45: Only support POE power supply
8	DC: Used for 12V power input power supply
9	3.0(Device): Connect USB host, upgrade system, etc
10	Wall-mounted components


2. Camera Usage

Method 2:


Wall-mounted: Fix the bracket onto the Wall with screws (Figure 1).

3. Connection


Please connect the device as shown below before use.



4. Quick Start

- 1) Please use USB cable to connect this product to the computer.
- ② The device can be turned on after being connected to the power supply.
- ③ After successful startup, the product functions can be used.

5. Remote Control



- a. **1** : Mute Button, press to turn on or off the microphone.
- b. 🖓 : Press to enable/disable the auto framing function. (After pressing the button, the screen will display the status, " 👩 " means open, " 👩 " means off.)
- c. \diamondsuit : Direction Button. After zoom+/-, press the direction buttons to move the camera.

- d. OK: Confirm Button.
- ① Camera image initialization function: Press to restore the camera image to its original state.
- e. J: Answer the calls.
- f. **¬**: Hang up the calls.
- g. ರು ರು): Volume Button, press to adjust the system volume.
- h. \mathbb{Q} \mathbb{Q} : Digital Zooming, press to digitally zoom the camera. (Available only when auto framing is disabled). After zooming in, the direction button can move the picture.
- i. Presets:
- ① When the camera is turned on, can set and switch the presets in settings.

 (Available only when auto framing is disabled).
- ② Press and hold the number button "1/2" for 2 seconds to save the current view as a preset.
- ③ Each preset contains zooming level, viewing angle information. Up to two presets are supported.
- 4 Press 1/2 to switch amongst the presets.
